At LRH we offer two Graduate Midwifery Programs; a Direct Entry Midwifery Program and a Double Degree Nursing and Midwifery Program (12 or 18 month option).

LRH's Thomson Ward is a Level 5 Maternity service supporting about 900 births a year. LRH also has a Level 4 Special Care Nursery.

Thomson is a 30 bed integrated maternity unit and throughout your time on Thomson you will work across all areas.
